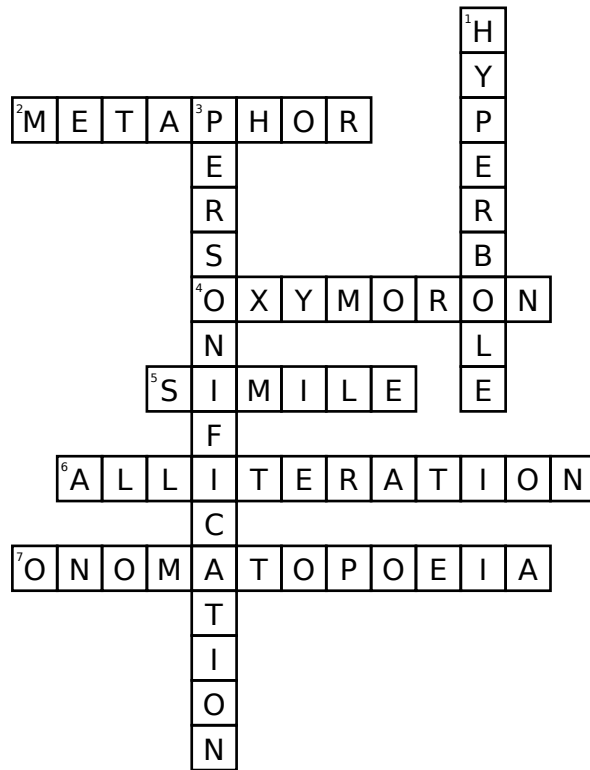


Figurative Language Crossword Puzzle



Down:

1. an exaggeration so dramatic that no one would believe it's true (I'm so hungry I could eat a horse!)
3. gives human characteristics to an animal or object (The tree danced in the wind.)

Across:

2. uses comparison to state a fact or paint a literary image (The man was boiling mad.)
4. joins two opposite ideas to create an effect (She is seriously funny.)
5. uses the words "like" or "as" to compare objects or ideas (The empty well was as dry as a bone.)
6. repeats the same first letter or sound in a series of words (Sir Samuel sailed the seven seas.)
7. a word which creates a sound effect to mimic an object or action (The cereal went snap crackle pop.)
